





### **ACCESS & PREPARATION**

Area to unload gear and easy access to parking (if possible)

### **INSTALLATION & BALANCE**

- Unloading: 25 minutes
- Installation time on stage: 30 minutes
- Balance duration: 30 minutes
- Set length: 90 min or up to (2) 45-60 min sets

### **DRESSING ROOMS**

Green room with towels and yoga mat

### LIGHTING DESIGN GUIDE (90-MIN SET)

1. MY THEORY - Dark cool silhouettes, low blues to purple

**2. AIN'T NO BRIAN WILSON -** Red, mood shift on intro, flashing on guitar solo, silhouettes on 2nd chorus

VAMP 1 - Flashing crazy (dramatic dance), spotlight on Becca if possible

3. CONTACT - Start off chill/night to disco magic

VAMP 2 - "Are you ready? Are you READY ??" FLASHING lights

**4. VIBRATE ON -** End of the night vibe, chill until solo, WHITE/FLASHING lights at end of guitar solo when ORGAN comes in

*VAMP -* HOLD LONG ORGAN CHORD (right after "Vibrate ON" ending) DRAMA, flashing lights until drums stop and count off into next song

**5. SONG 7 SHORT SONG -** Dark cool silhouette interlude, horn feature if lighting can spotlight them; warm tones, aggressive vocal, final psyche out... could get *crazy* here

"HELLO THERE! WE'RE THE GENTLEMAN BRAWLERS, 1 2 3 4 .... " SPOTLIGHT Becca

**6. DARK SIDE -** chill mid-tempo vibe, red wash, spotlight on keys; psyche out near end of song led by keys feature — feel free to go crazy here wtih FLASHING LIGHTS then return to red wash as a bookend

**7. ATWER ABROPA** - chill mid-tempo Afrobeat instrumental; horn and guitar trade feature; low blues to purple

**8. POWER SURGES -** Spotlight on keyboard intro then warm wash on stage, crazier as song goes, spotlight on Becca in verses if possible, spotlight Matt then horns then Matt on mid-instrumental break

**9. BLACK DOG -** Spotlight on Becca as song begins, gradually growing as band kicks in; play with dynamics between intimate vocal moments (spotlighting) to dramatic shift to pulsing (white lights?); near end of song if possible to spotlight Becca's dance feature alongwith highlighting horns playing feature that would be great; black out

*VAMP 4 -* DRUMS 4 BAR INTRO cueing slowly growing keyboard pad; lights can gradually grow as music crescendos, quickly stopping and snapping into next song



**10. POISON APPLE -** Pulsing latin samba groove; dance-heavy for the crowd so feel free to go crazy here FLASHING lights; song ends with guitar solo that can extend depending

### LIGHTING DESIGN GUIDE (90-MIN SET - cont'd)

**11. PERMANENT WAVES -** Dark cool silhouettes, low blues to purple; SPOTLIGHT Becca on keys until chorus when stage light can fill more; SPOTLIGHT sax solos after 1st and 2nd chorus

**12. KANDO BONGO MAN -** Neverending afro highlife party song; guitar and horn feature; Becca and dancers go into crowd, so anyway to bring lighting offstage in moments would be a nice highlight; song often extends

**13. HIT SNOOZE -** Wake up song! Bright lights on stage b/w Becca and Quincie singing duet and choreographed dance; sometimes will bring audience member on stage for this

**14. MORE SUCCESSFUL EX-FRIEND -** chill mid-tempo vibe, red wash, spotlight BECCA; QUINCIE alter-ego dance feature

15. WHY DON'T I LISTEN - chill mid-tempo vibe, blues/greens/magentas

**16. RECKLESS EYEBALLIN** - chill mid-tempo Afrobeat instrumental; horn and guitar trade feature; low blues to purple

17. UNDER THE STARS - Brighter, party vibe
